

Easy Origami Boat

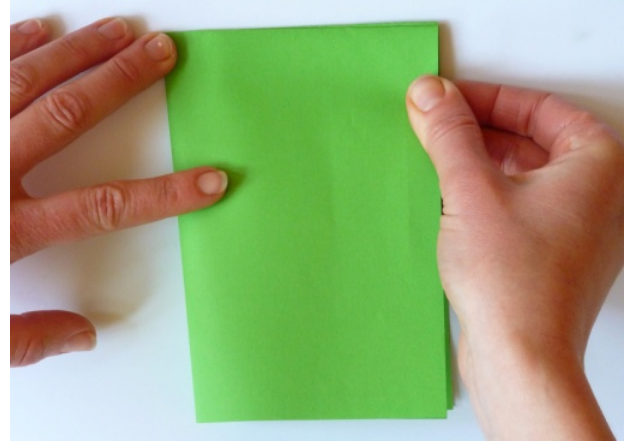
You will need: A piece of A4 paper.

Top tips: Lean on a flat surface & make your folds as neat as you can.

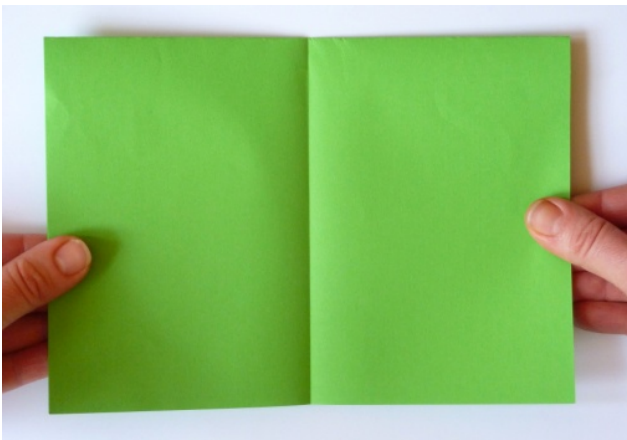
1. Fold paper in half so that the straight sides meet. It is now A5 size.



2. Fold in half again. (A6 size)



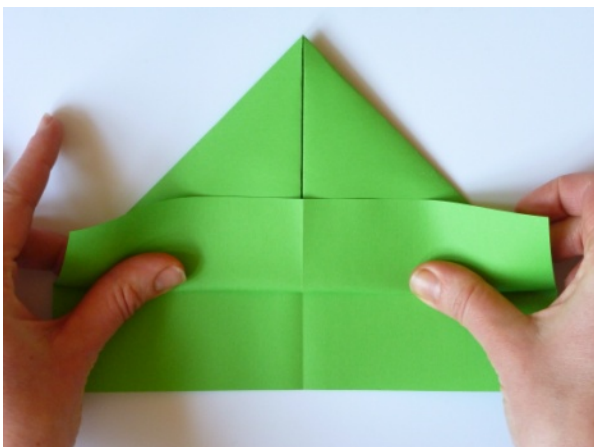
3. Open it, so it looks like a book.



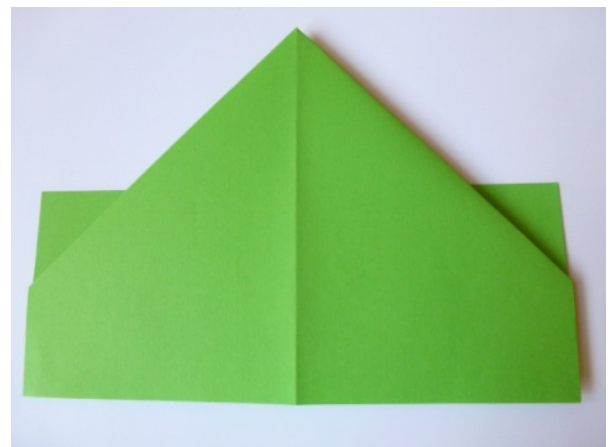
4. With the folded edge at the top, bring the upper 2 corners to meet on the central line.



5. Fold the bottom edge upwards.



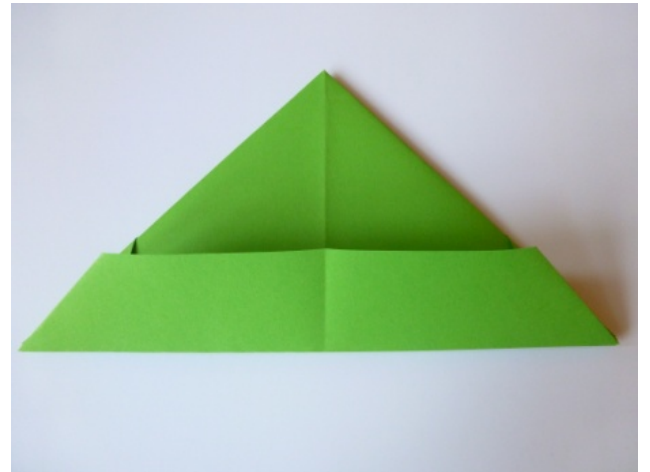
6. Turn your paper over. **Do not repeat the last step on this side.**



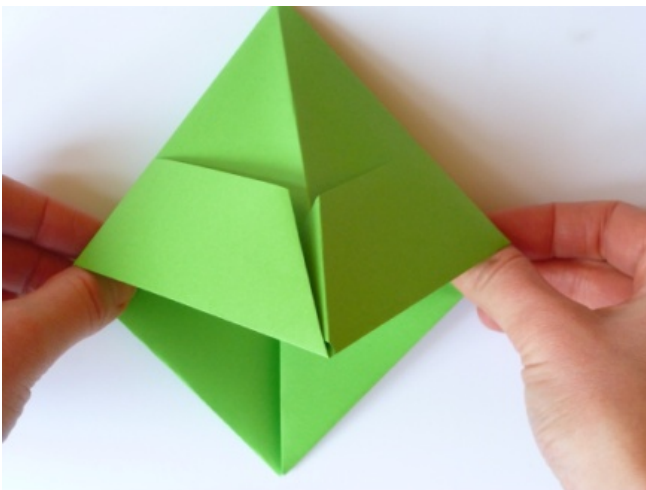
7. Bring 4 corners to meet each other.



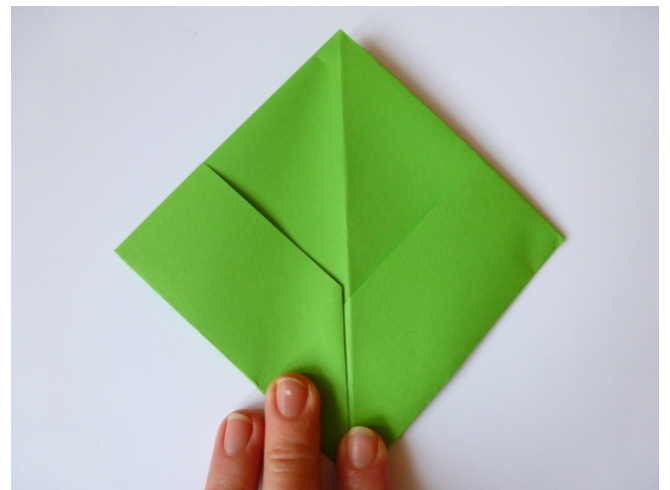
8. Fold the lower flap upwards.



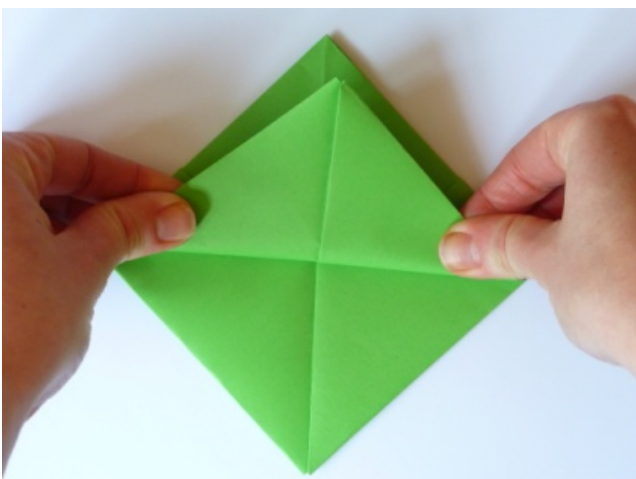
9. Push the two points together until it starts to look like a beak shape. Push the sides completely together.



10. You should now have a flat square or diamond shape.



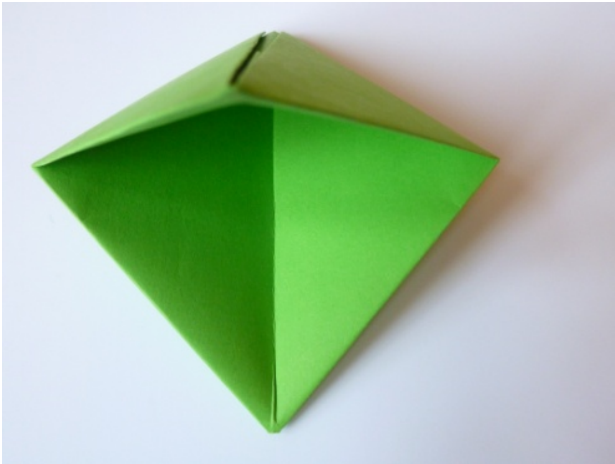
11. Fold the lower point up to meet the upper point, creating a triangle.



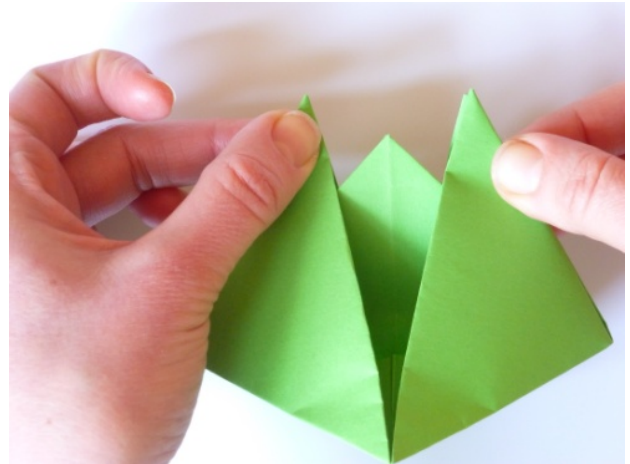
12. Turn over and repeat.



13. Make a beak shape again, by pushing in from the sides. Then squash it flat.



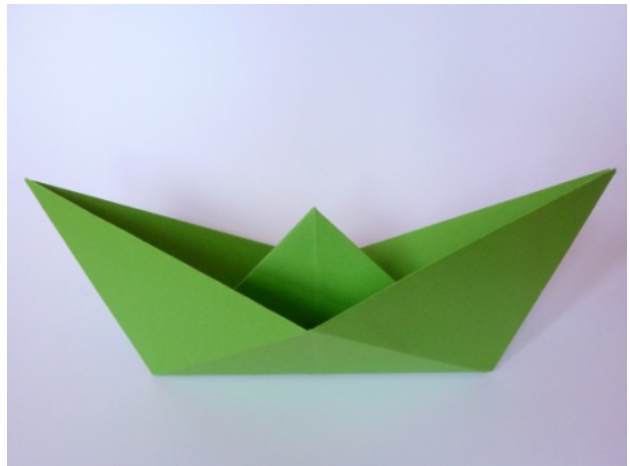
14. Find 2 points at the top and pull them away from each other.



15. Squash flat.



16. You're now ready to float your boat!
