

# Intermediate Origami Boat

**You will need:** A square piece of paper. If it is patterned, pattern face down.

**Top tips:** Lean on a flat surface & make your folds as perfect as you can

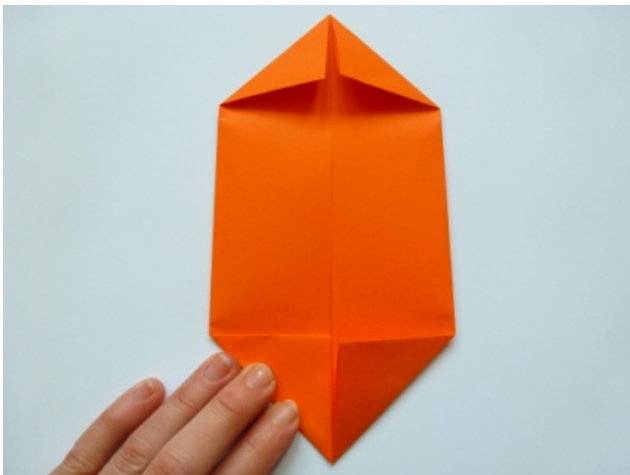
1. Fold paper in half so that the straight sides meet. Then open it out.



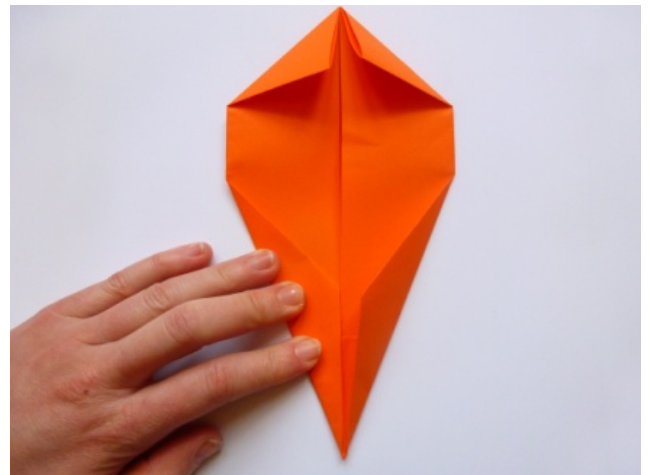
2. Fold both sides in, so they meet on the central fold.



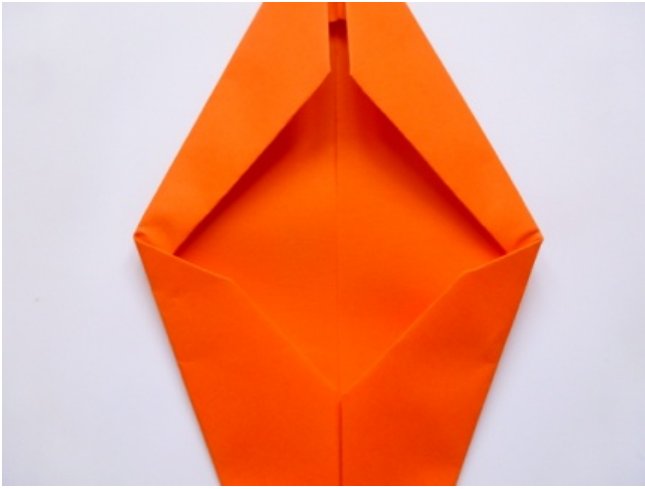
3. Fold all 4 corners in, so that they meet on the central line. You should now have 4 small triangles.



4. Fold the lower 2 corners in to meet on the central line.



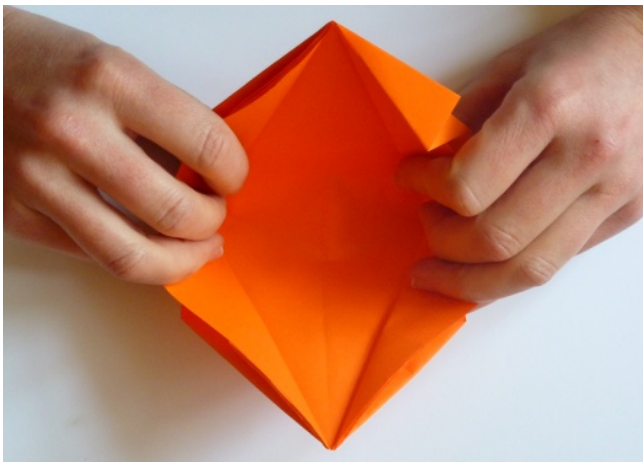
**5.** Fold the upper 2 corners in to meet on the central line. (It won't quite look symmetrical now)



**6.** Fold the 2 points at the side to meet the central line.



**7.** Now comes the tricky bit! Carefully turn your boat inside out, starting in the centre. Don't worry, it will get a bit scrunched up and look a bit messy along the way.



**8.** You are now ready to float your boat!
